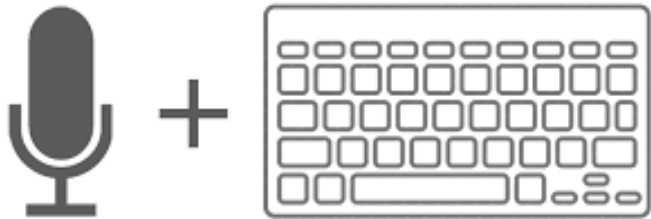
EclipseVox™ A-Z is a comprehensive training on the fundamentals of the EclipseVox™ CAT software. There are three offerings based on your level of experience.

EclipseVox™ *Get Up and Go!* would be appropriate for brand new users of the software (or those with minimal training in their voice writing programs) and is a broad overview laying the foundation and tools necessary to complete a job from take down to delivery.

EclipseVox™ A-Z *Basic* would be appropriate for fairly new users or existing EclipseVox™ users with very minimal experience or formal training with the software desiring to gain a better understanding and knowledge of voice recognition and the EclipseVox™ software and how they work together.

EclipseVox™ A-Z *Plus* would be appropriate for more experienced users with a general working knowledge and understanding of the software. The sessions entail an overview of the basic fundamentals with a more in-depth approach to the advanced features.

ECLIPSEVOX™ AND WHAT YOU'LL LEARN



The EclipseVox™ program objective is to provide the trainee with a comprehensive understanding of working with voice-to-text technology, customizing Dragon speech recognition software, maintaining strong voice profiles and increasing recognition accuracy and incorporating that into the basic fundamentals of EclipseVox™ in order to achieve excellent output results and more efficient transcript production.

Each of the programs give the user four (4) months access to the content. Access may be extended for a nominal fee.

EclipseVox™ A-Z *Get Up and Go!* consists of 5 pre-recorded sessions with accompanying materials.

EclipseVox™ A-Z *Basic* consists of 6 pre-recorded sessions with accompanying materials.

EclipseVox™ A-Z *Plus* consists of 6 pre-recorded sessions with accompanying materials.

PRE-REQUISITES

Participant must possess:

- A solid working knowledge of the Windows environment and intermediate to advanced computer skills. Windows 10 Professional is recommended.
- Above-average grammar, punctuation and spelling skills
- Adequate typing skills

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Business class Intel or AMD i7 quad-core high-quality processor or Ryzen 7 AMD processor; minimum 16 gig RAM; 512 SSD, Windows 10 or 11 Professional. These are minimum requirements and it is recommended to upgrade where budget allows.
- Dragon Professional - *NOTE: Version 15 is no longer available. If you don't already own it, you'll need to purchase Version 16. I strongly recommend purchasing from KnowBrainer. Additionally, you can get your mask and Andrea sound device from KB as well. You will need to call to order - 615-884-4558 or email: lunis@knowbrainer.com*

- USB Audio Device (Sound Card) – [Andrea PureAudio MA or SA](#); [SoundBlaster Play3](#); are recommended choices. *[The links provided are for informational purposes only. You may find them for less at other retailers.]*
- Transcription foot pedal – Infinity [USB-2](#) is recommended. [USB-3](#) is available and works with both of the recommended transcription software above as well as with EclipseVox™ Version 10. It is NOT compatible with v9 or lower of EclipseVox™.
- Wired earbuds or headphones (noise cancelling recommended). Do not get a headset with a microphone.
- *Assistance with procuring all items is available.
