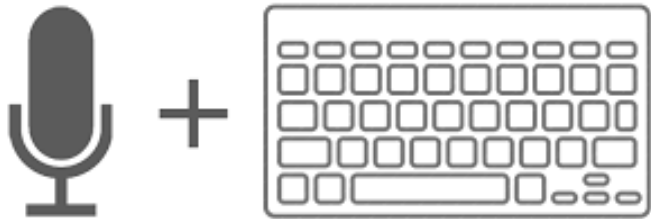


EclipseVox™ A-Z is a comprehensive training on the fundamentals of the EclipseVox™ CAT software. There are two offerings based on your level of experience.

EclipseVox™ A-Z *Plus* would be appropriate for more experienced users with a general working knowledge and understanding of the software. The sessions entail an overview of the basic fundamentals with a more in-depth approach to the features.

The EclipseVox™ A-Z course objective is to provide the trainee with a comprehensive understanding of working with voice-to-text technology, customizing Dragon speech recognition software, building strong voice profiles and increasing recognition accuracy and incorporating that into the basic fundamentals of EclipseVox™ in order to achieve excellent output results and more efficient transcript production.





ECLIPSEVOX™ A-Z

- Length: Each of the EclipseVox™ A-Z courses are eight (8) weeks of live virtual instruction (with bonus pre-recorded instructional videos)
- When: Class is held one evening per week, TBD per session (this will be the same night each week). All classes are conducted Eastern Standard Time, and are recorded for unlimited reference and playback throughout the program length and for a full 60 days thereafter.
- Where: Via online meeting platform (Zoom or GoTo).

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Business class Intel or AMD i7 quad-core high-quality processor; 16 gig RAM; 512 SSD, Windows 10 or 11 Professional. These are minimum requirements and it is recommended to upgrade where budget allows.
- Dragon Professional 15.3 (recommended) or higher. [NOTE: It is recommended that you purchase the 15.3 & 15.6 combined from [Knowbrainer](#). Install 15.3.]
- Stenomask: [Talk Technologies SR Pro-1](#) is recommended [Google it, you may find less at other retailers.]
- USB Audio Device (Sound Card) – [Andrea PureAudio MA or SA](#); [SoundBlaster Play3](#); [Speechware](#) are recommended choices. [The links provided are for informational purposes only. You may find them for less at other retailers.]
- Transcription foot pedal – Infinity [USB-2](#) is recommended. [USB-3](#) is available and works with both of the recommended transcription software above as well as with EclipseVox™ Version 10. It is NOT compatible with v9 or lower of EclipseVox™.
- Wired earbuds or headphones (noise cancelling recommended). Do not get a headset with a microphone.
- *Assistance with procuring all items is available.
